



Micro Baby Hat Knitting Pattern 1

made in the round with double pointed needles

In loving memory of Evan James Chrysler



Directions

- Use weight 4 yarn (baby yarn is best) and size 7 double pointed needles
- XXS sizing should be around 1.5 inches tall and wide
- XS around 2.5 inches
- S around 3.5 inches

- Stitch count for size XXS (~1.5 inch), XS (~2 inch), S (~2.5 inch) respectively in parentheses

- Long tail cast on (16, 21, 26 stitches) and divide between 3 double pointed needles
- Without twisting the cast on, do an invisible join (15, 20, 25 sts)
- R1-6 : knit in the round
- Add 1 knit round for XS and 2 knit rounds for S size

- Decreasing:
 - For small size start here - [Knit 3, knit 2 together] around (20 stitches - continue to next line)
 - For XS size, start here - [knit 2, knit 2 together] around (15 stitches - continue to next line)
 - For XXS size, start here - [knit 1, knit 2 together] around (10 stitches - continue to next line)

- All sizes – [knit 2 together] around (5 sts remaining)
 - Cut a tail leaving enough to close project and work with (mine ~ 6 inches)
 - Use a crochet hook or yarn needle to thread through the remaining stitches and pull to close the hole closed as much as you can
 - Pull tail to the inside of the hat - flip hat inside out and tie off the working tail
 - While hat is inside out, tie off the tail from the beginning of the hat and weave in ends

- Add a pom pom or two to the top as desired!

- Pattern can easily be adjusted to other sizing by adjusting cast on by multiples of 5 + 1 if you prefer different size needles or weighted yarn.
