

Micro Baby Wrap Pattern

In loving memory of Evan James Chrysler

Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet

St = slip stitch

Hook size = 3.5 E or 4.0 F



Directions


Ch22

- Row1: dc in 3rd ch from the hook. Dc in each chain all the way down (20) Ch2, turn project
- Rows2-10: dc 20, ch2, turn project. (20) at the end of row 10, fasten off, leaving a 12" yarn tail for sewing

Fold each side in toward the middle, then sew the bottom shut by starting in the middle. Sew to one side, then back to the middle, then sew to the other side, then back to the middle again. Next, sew the two sides of the body together on the edges for about 2-3 rows or a little under halfway up. Turn piece inside out, then add a bow to tie shut.

To make this wrap bigger or smaller, add or subtract however many ch in the beginning. You might have more or fewer than 10 rows depending on the size you choose. Once you have a decent square, sew it up. The number of rows does not matter.
